



- 20. Industry-leading heavy-duty fiberglass transom door on applicable models is not only for big fish, it is a safety feature and provides easy access for tow sports, swimming, snorkeling, and more. Solid, 316 stainless transom door hardware is highlighted by an easy-to-use, oversized latch with a positive locking mechanism for added safety.
- 21. Aluminum transom brace is bonded and screwed to the top of the transom of most models, and through bolted to the longitudinal stringer system. On integrated bracket models the bracing is through bolted to the stringer system.
- **22. Retractable ski pylon option** makes many models go from superb family fishing machine to watersport wonder in minutes.
